Application Requirements:

- Current member of ASTMH
- Provide a Statement of Interest (one page maximum) describing why you would like to serve on the Committee, a description of your professional background that aligns with the charge to this Committee or prior experience on a committee or activity in a related area.
- Provide an up-to-date CV.

Roles and Responsibilities of Committee:

- Committee members can serve a total of two three-year terms (six years total). At the end of the first term, the Chair has the option to invite members to serve an additional three-year term. Staff assists with invitations and thank-you-for-your-service letters.
- The Committee Chair can serve a maximum of two terms, three years each. A committee member will be given priority to become Chair. In this case, a committee member could potentially serve two terms as a member and then two terms as the Chair for a total of 12 years of service.
- Time commitment: A total of approximately 5 hours annually during the months of February, March and April. The business of the Committee will be carried out through at least one conference call and primarily through email. Committee members are expected to attend the Soper and Craig Lectures at the Annual Meeting.
